

A natural phenomenon: the ceramic facade system of Agrob Buchtal

LANDSCAPE IN THE LIGHT



On the edge of the city centre of Rennes, three residential buildings rise out of the natural space like a rock formation. Despite a close look, the materiality of the architecture remains hidden for a long time. The KeraTwin ceramic system from Agrob Buchtal makes the landscape possible in the light.



The ceramic façade by Agrob Buchtal skilfully captures the light and changes its appearance throughout the day.

At nightfall, the façades are illuminated and form the new nocturnal silhouette of the Confluence.







KeraTwin by Agrob Buchtal envelops the project in a colour gradient from grey to white, with a texture from matt to glossy, creating the impression of rock.



The exterior façades curve and the interior façades are cut to provide as many terraces as possible.



The envelope offers different types of outdoor spaces for the flats: Winter gardens, loggias, balconies and generous terraces also contribute functionally to shading, as privacy screens, noise protection and windbreaks.



The buildings consistently mix social housing and condominiums, large and smaller flats with dual and triple orientations.



Octroi is welcoming, with the quality of life of a village where residents can experience the existing natural space and cultural living environment communally.
